USA = Over The Counter product

Canada = Natural Health Product or Drug

Australia = Therapeutic Good

Japan = cosmetic

China = Special use cosmetics

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REACH like regulations

Japan: some substance of CSCL are banned in cosmetics + poison list

USA: TSCA, evaluation of D4 (cyclotetrasiloxane)





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CHINA

2020-2021: Full change of regulation

- ⇒ Drafts still under consultation
- ⇒ Texts recently published (>10)
- ⇒ Text interpretation from authorities unknown
- ⇒ Uncertainty

2 categories of cosmetics:

- General cosmetics (notification)
- Special use cosmetics (registration)

Ingredients:

- Positive list (IECIC 2021)
- For new ingredients registration or notification
- Exhaustive information mandatory

Animal testing still mandatory. Exemptions possible for general cosmetics under certain conditions.

Labelling: Chinese

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


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
SOUTH KOREA

Products categories

- Quasi-drugs
- Functional cosmetics
- General cosmetics



⇒ Functional cosmetics and quasi-drugs: registration and approval before marketing.



forbidden, restricted and positive lists for preservatives, UV filters, colorants

For functional cosmetics: list of recognised actives. Other actives may be used, but with longer approval periods and more testing.

Others:

- Regulation on customised cosmetics
- Regulation on natural and organic cosmetics

<u>Labelling:</u> Korean langage + Korean INCI



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Andean Community

Members:

Bolivia, Columbia, Ecuador, Peru

The ingredient used in cosmetic shall be compliant to the bans, restrictions and conditions of use of the international lists:

- **FDA**
- Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 (as well as its amendments)
- Cosmetics Toiletry & Fragrance Association (CTFA)
- ⇒ Mandatory sanitary notification Labelling: Spanish
- ⇒ General texts for the area but specificities in each country


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FUROPEAN UNION

Regulation 1223/2009 fully applicable in the 27 EU countries since 2013.

Online notification for each product Mandatory to have a responsible person for the EU market



Banned, restricted, positive lists for preservatives, UV filters, colorants

Product Information File with a Safety Assessment of the cosmetic product

Labelling: langage of the Member State





JAPAN

Categories of products:

- Cosmetics
- Quasi-Drugs

No notification for cosmetics Registration and approval mandatory for quasi-drugs

Substances:

- Standard for cosmetics: banned substances, restricted substances, positive lists for UV filters and preservatives
- Ordinance No 66: authorised coal-tar colorants

Labelling:


Japanese and japanese INCI Claims strictly regulated



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TURKEY

Regulation similar to the European Union



Cosmetic File with a Safety Assessment of the cosmetic product

Lists of regulated substances:

Banned, restricted, positive lists for preservatives, UV filters, colorants

Langage: partly in Turkish







USA

Responsibility of the manufacturers for the products safety Control of the market by the authorities

Substances:

Banned and restricted substances Positive list for colorants CIR recommendations

Labelling:

English

INCI with some changes



No cosmetic file Notification on voluntary basis Good Manufacturing Practises only voluntary

CANADA

Mandatory statement for cosmetics

Critical list of ingredients which use is restricted or forbidden in cosmetics

Labelling: English and French

Categories of products:

- Cosmetics
- **Natural Health Products**

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EURASIAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY

Members:

Russia, Kazakhstan, Byelorussia, Armenia, Kyrgyzstan

Regulation TR/TC 009/2011, based on the EU regulation

- ⇒ Registration or declaration of conformity
- ⇒ Lists of substances : banned, restricted, positive lists of UV filters, preservatives, colorants

Safety evaluation: toxicological tests in certified russian laboratory

Labelling: langage of the member state

COSMED

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
