Global Product Compliance

- 1. Legal pass for products to enter the market.
- 2. The import, production, sale, use and advertising of unregistered fertilizer products are prohibited.
- 3. Fertilizer manufacturing enterprises have production capacity.
- 4. The product quality and effect meet the requirements.



Competent Authority

National MOA

Responsible for the national fertilizer registration, supervision and management



Provincial MOA

Accept applications for fertilizer registration of factories in their region, evaluate the production conditions, and issue draft decision.



County MOA

Responsible for the supervision and management of fertilizers in their region.

Organic Water-soluble Fertilizers

Definition: a liquid or solid water-soluble fertilizer containing biostimulant components including: free amino acids, humic acid, seaweed extract, chitosan, polyglutamic acid, polyaspartic acid, molasses, low value fish, fermenting degradation products and other organic resources, as the main raw materials, adding appropriate amount of macroelements, secondary elements or micro-elements according to the needs of plant growth, processed by physical, chemical or biological processes.

Types (by raw material):

- 1) Seaweeds: Kelp, Ascophyllum Nodosum, cagassum, Phaeophyta, etc.;
- 2) Chitin from Shrimp shell and crab shell;
- 3) Molasses fermentation concentrate;
- 4) Low-value fish;
- 5) Other categories: Pomace, Corn steep liquor, soybean meal, etc.

Technical specification: Organic matter; pH; water-insoluble matter, (macro elements, medium elements, and micro-elements)

Cu, Fe, Mn, Zn, B, Mo \geq 0.05% or 0.5 g/L, and Mo \leq 1.0% or 10 g/L

•Type 1: Exemption of registration

Ammonia sulfate, Urea, Ammonium nitrate, Calcium cyanamide Ammonium phosphate(mono and di), Phosphor nitrate, Calcium superphosphate, Potassium chloride, Potassium sulfate Potassium nitrate, Ammonium chloride, Ammonium bicarbonate, Calcium magnesium Phosphate, Potassium dihydrogen phosphate Single microelement fertilizers, High concentration compound fertilizers

•Type 2: Registration at provincial level

Compound fertilizers; Bulk blending fertilizers; Organic-inorganic compound fertilizers; Organic fertilizers; Soil acid regulating agents

•Type 3: Products out of Fertilizer Registration scope

Homemade organic fertilizer produced by the farmers Fertilizer-pesticide mixtures (Pesticide registration) Plant growth regulators (Pesticide registration)



Fertilizer Registration documents (Imported products)

- 1. Application form
- 2. Product Safety Data (Products with high risks)
- 3. Test reports: field trial (In China)
- 4. Draft label (Chinese)
- 5. Label in country of origin
- 6. Enterprise and product information including: basic information of the enterprise, enterprise Product R&D report, manufacturing process
- 7. Product Quality Commitment
- 9. Business license (Chinese agent)
- 10. Agency Agreement
- 11. Enterprise registration certificate issued by the government of the country (region)
- 12. Production and sales certificate approved by fertilizer management organization
- 13. Pictures of production and testing equipment
- 14. Product samples
- 15. Other documents: trademark, ISO.

Special Documents for Imported Products

Documents



Proof that the applicant is a fertilizer manufacturer, legally registered in its country.

Original foreign label

Proof that the product's technical indicators and scope of use sold in its original are consistent with which will be put in Chinese market

Certificate of production and sales of registered products


Proof that the applied product is legally produced and sold in its country.

Agency Agreement

Determine the responsibilities of both foreign applicant and Chinese agent.

Foreign Applicant and Chinese Agent

- 1. Foreign applicant: Fertilizer manufacturer need to set up a resident representative office or entrust a Chinese agent.
- 2. Chinese agent(or Office): Sole agent, responsible for handling fertilizer registration, packaging, import fertilizer and other services on behalf of foreign applicants, and bear corresponding legal responsibilities in China.
- 3. Foreign applicant and Chinese agent(or Office): Sign the agency agreement, the agency agreement should clearly define the above responsibilities.



Change Agent



Choosing the right sales agent in China is very important!

- 1. Application form;
- 2. Termination agreement with former sales agent;
- 3. New Agent Agreement with new sales agent;
- 4. New product label;
- 5. Business License of New Agency;

Note: If there are disputes between the two parties in trade or law, the MOA will not accept agency change.



Risk Points and How to Avoid Risks?


- 1. Unsatisfactory sales
- 2. Lack of responsibility
- 3. Tense relations
- 4. Unauthorized OEM processing
- 5. Little or no import

Registered products

- 1. Chemical fertilizer and microbial fertilizer
- 2. Standard products and non-standard products
- 3. Meet the requirements of Chinese standards

Documents from Country of origin

- 1. Business Registration Certificate
- 2. Certificate of production and sales of registered products
- 3. Original foreign label



Chinese sales agent

- 1. Set up own company in China
- 2. Sign conditional contract with Chinese agent/
- 3. Register own patent and trademark in China

Technical confidentiality

- 1. Detailed production process
- 2. All production equipments
- 3. Personnel and financial information
